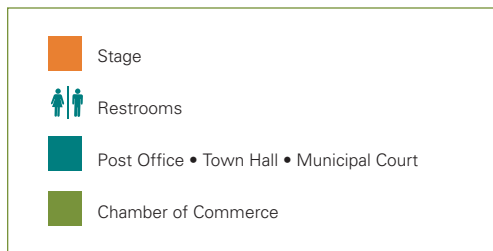
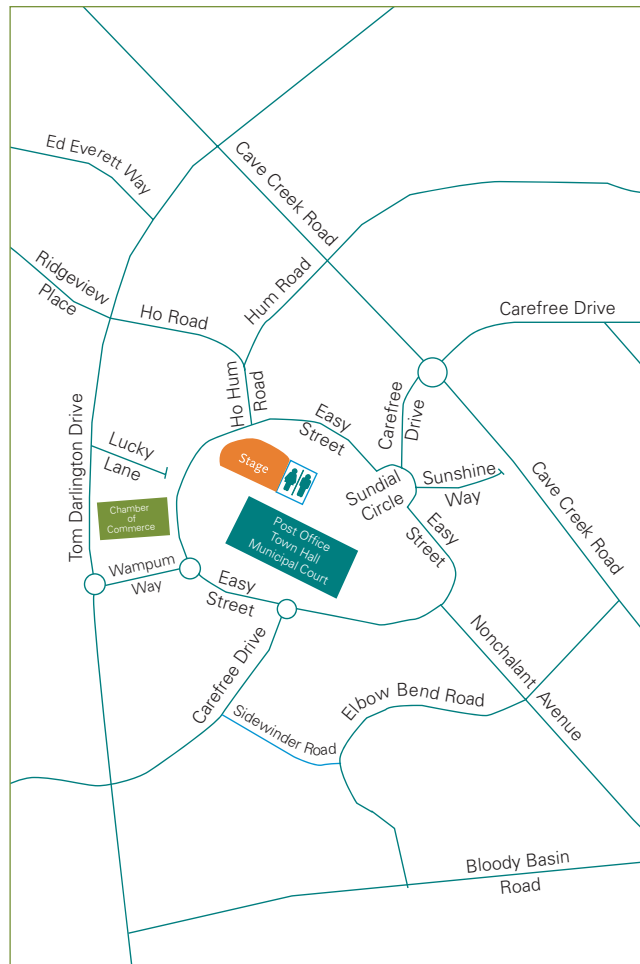

Some of the market finds are local pesticide free New River Tomatoes and certified organic produce including organic ciders, apples and salad mixes and greens fresh from the farms. All our produce is seasonal and reflects the change of what is growing right now in our valley.

You can also find specialty foods that range from a wide selection of salsas, jams and jellies, barbecue sauces, organic coffees, freshly baked artisan breads, scones and cookies as well as gourmet olive oil from the Queen Creek Olive Mill. Other products that may be found are local cheeses and cage free eggs; plants and flowers, depending on local availability. And directly from our ranchers and fishermen you can also find beef raised on sweet grasses, wild Alaskan salmon, cod and halibut. 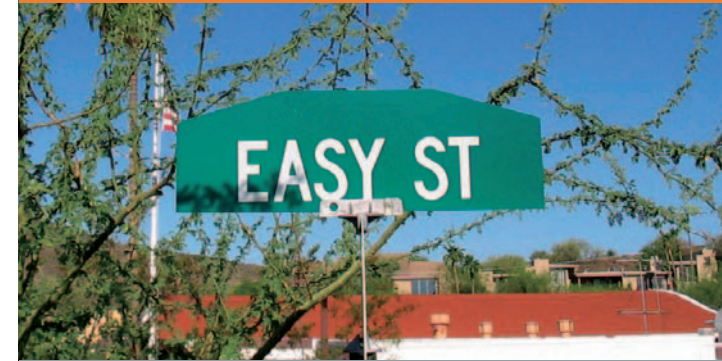

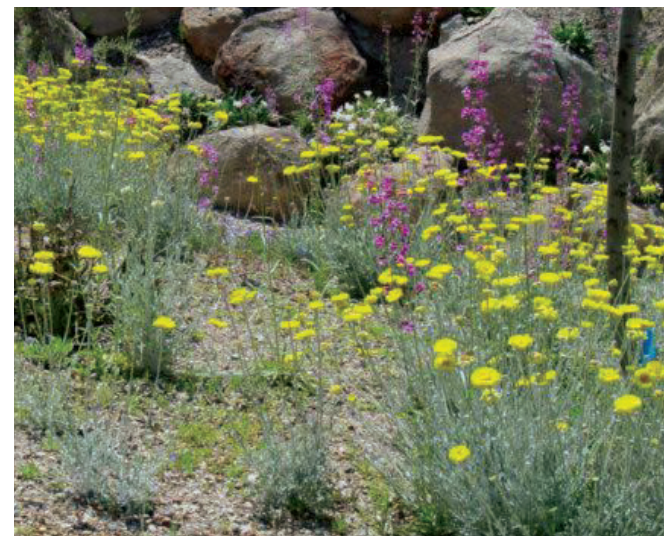
